### June 5 - Woody Pines

Woody Pines is an internationally acclaimed North Carolina singer/guitarist/harmonicist/songwriter who plays rousing roots music, which includes country, jazz, ragtime, jug band, Dixieland, folk and old-time country blues. He and his band rock and soar, and unfailingly bring crowds to their feet all over the country.

### June 12 - Parrots of the Caribbean

The Parrots of the Caribbean is a Jimmy Buffett tribute band, and an annual highlight of the summer series. The group has performed together for seven years and has earned the reputation as the #1 Buffett tribute band in the USA. It will be a memorable night for Parrotheads!

### June 19 - Capital Sound

Based out of Columbus, the Capital Sound band is a big band with an enormous sound; it has a five-piece rhythm section and a four-piece horn section. The band plays funk, blues, soul and rock from the 50's to the present day. Capital Sound has opened for REO Speedwagon and the Roots from the Jimmy Fallon Show.

### June 26 - The British Invasion

The British Invasion band covers all of the music from the British bands of the sixties and seventies: the Beatles, the Rolling Stones, the Kinks, the Who, the Dave Clark Five, the Hollies and Herman's Hermits, just to name a few. Everything has been reproduced to detail – music, hairstyles and clothing!

### July 4th Band - The Arnett Howard Band

The Red Hot Rhythm Review performs rhythm and blues, funk and classics. Well-known singer Tammy Walkup performs lead vocals.
